Summer Enrichment Camp Information and Guidelines**

Instruction & Staffing Ratios

Students are taught by professional artists and/or art educators. The staff-to-student ratio is at a maximum 1:8 for the Camp.

Enrollee Age/Grade Requirements

Camps are organized by grade level to meet the developmental needs of our campers. Campers should be starting the designated grade in the fall of the same year. Ages 12-17

Meals & Snacks

All camps have a scheduled lunch and a scheduled snack time, so we ask that you send your child to camp with a brown bag lunch that **DOES NOT** require refrigeration or heating as well as a healthy snack. TRYP's The S.T.U.D.I.O. Experience does not provide lunches or snacks. If your child has food sensitivities, please include that information on your registration form so that we can make appropriate accommodations.

Drop-off & Pick-up

All camps are scheduled to begin at 9am and end at 4pm. Drop-off is from 8:30 am to 9:00 am. Pick-up is from 4:00 pm to 4:30 pm. Further drop-off/pick-up instructions will be provided. Please stay in your vehicle and a staff member will assist you and your child(ren). If you choose to park and walk your child in, please be mindful of the authorized and/or legal parking requirements in the area. Please be prompt.

ON JUNE 30, FINAL DAY OF CAMP WE WILL HAVE EXTENDED HOURS FOR OUR STUDENT SHOWCASE.
SHOWCASE WILL CONCLUDE AT 5:30. FRIENDS AND FAMILY ARE INVITED TO ATTEND.

PLEASE ARRIVE 15-20 MINUTES EARLY ON FIRST DAY TO COMPLETE REGISTRATION PROCESS

Sign In & Out

All enrollees must be signed in and out every day. Your child must be picked up at the end of the day by you or the authorized adult you named in your registration. If you need to add an additional authorized adult, you must submit, in advance, their full name via email to registration@remarkableyouth.org.

Behavior Policy

Fun and safety are only possible when there are behavior guidelines. Students are expected to show respect for fellow campers, staff, themselves and the campus facilities. Due to safety concerns, disruptive behavior and physical aggression are not tolerated. Our camp staff are trained to use positive management tools in the camps. If any camper does not respond to these methods, they will be escorted to the office for a time-out. If the problem persists, campers may be removed from the program with no refund.

Illness Policy

If your child is unable to participate in camp due to illness, we ask that you keep them at home, both for their own wellness, and to maintain a healthy environment for the other participants. We are unable to offer refunds for missed camp days because your camp fees support the operational costs of the camp as a whole. We appreciate your understanding.

What to Bring

Clothing: Our camps and workshops are activity-oriented and students will spend a significant amount of time working on their projects. Please make sure your child has comfortable clothing and comfortable walking shoes.

Sunscreen: Please apply sunscreen before camp. You may send sunscreen along with your child for re-application.

Drinks: We recommend that students bring a water bottle with them daily as we may spend time outside and the weather will most likely be warm. A drinking fountain is available near the classroom area.

Snacks and Lunch: Snacks and lunch **will not** be provided by The Remarkable Youth Project. We ask that students bring their own lunch, in addition to a healthy snack.

Medications: Please make sure that medications have been given prior to arrival at The Remarkable Youth Project. Please include on your registration form any information about relevant medical issues, including medications that will need to be taken during camp hours. (Please note: The Remarkable Youth Project staff will not be responsible for administering medications.)

Cancellation and refund policy

Camp sessions are subject to cancellation or change due to low enrollment. You will be notified at least (2) weeks in advance if your camp session is cancelled. In this instance, you will receive a full refund in the original form of payment.

Should you choose to cancel your registration for any reason, please refer to the tiered policy below:

Up to fourteen (14) days before your camp start date, you will receive a refund in the original form of payment, less a 10% administrative fee.

Less than fourteen (14) days before your camp start date, no refunds will be given. Camp fees can be allocated toward another camp during the same camp program within the same year but choices are subject to availability. A 10% fee will apply.

If your child is unable to participate in camp due to illness, we ask that you keep them at home, both for their own wellness, and to maintain a healthy environment for the other participants. We are unable to offer refunds for missed camp days because your camp fees support the operational costs of the camp as a whole. We appreciate your understanding.
